With more than 25 years of practice in Occupational Medicine, Dr. Davids started his career as a Medical Officer with the Canadian Armed Forces, subsequently serving as Medical Advisor and Director for organizations in retail, manufacturing and nuclear energy sectors as well as police services, healthcare and education.

Dr. Davids has extensive experience working with unionized workforces in Occupational Health & Safety. He has acted as an advisor to Human Resources, Labour Relations and Legal, and has testified in Labour arbitrations and Human Rights tribunals. He has managed and advised corporate clients on Public Health concerns that impact business continuity, employees, and customers, conducted and advised on Corporate Executive Medicals and Wellness initiatives, and has provided Travel Medicine consultations for business travel for corporate clients.
